Abstract

The paper addresses the penetration of new technologies in the Chilean legal profession, in order to explain the curricular innovation of the minor in artificial intelligence and law (IA+D), according to its learning outcomes. From this, it examines each subject that composes the IA+D minor, from a double point of view: the justification for the inclusion of each subject and its structuring oriented to the fulfillment of the expected profile with the approval of all the subjects of the minor.
